Dear Friends,

I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the **World Aquatics Coaches Certification Course – Coach Level (L2)** scheduled to be held in Sucre, Bolivia (BOL), from 18 – 22 July 2024. Please note the following information related to the World Aquatics Coaches Certification Programme and the Coach's Certification Pathway:

## Course description

- The objective of the World Aquatics Coaches Certification Programme is to promote sports' growth by offering a continuous learning pathway for coaches, providing, and setting the necessary competencies to complete the certification.
- The course will be delivered in Spanish.
- The candidates must fully participate in all sessions of the course and complete all the required assessments.

## Eligibility

- The World Aquatics Coaches Certification Courses Coach Level (L2) are open to all the National Federations interested in training and certifying their coaches.
- They are designed for those candidates with prior knowledge or coaching experience, preparing them for coaching duties in swimming.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of the World Aquatics
   Coaches Certification Programme.
- The Participants should have an Intermediate level of English.





## Registration

- Each National Member Federation may nominate coaches for this course.
   All participants must be registered by the <u>5 June 2024</u> in the <u>GMS</u> using your federation login details.
- Each profile must include the following information: personal data, photo, passport copy and the candidate's personal email address. Any application without all the above-mentioned information will be rejected.

## Approvals

 World Aquatics will start to approve the registrations once the required number of participants has been reached (10). The approvals will be done on a first come first served basis and according to the priority for attendance established on the <u>2022-2025 Certification Pathway</u>.

#### Assessment

- The official working language is English.
- For the written Face to Face exam, the use of interpreters, online resources and electronic devices is not permitted.
- In order to pass the course and become certified, a participant must pass the Online Course and the assessments available on the <u>Learning Platform</u> ideally before the end of the Face-to-Face Course. In addition, he/she must attend the Face-to-Face Course and pass the examination.
